Safety-Care™ Behavioral Safety Training program provides the skills and competencies necessary to effectively prevent, minimize, and manage behavioral challenges with dignity, safety, and the possibility of change. Using the newest and most effective technologies from Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS), this Safety-Care program will provide your staff with strategies for not only preventing and managing behavioral challenges, but also to effectively teaching replacement behaviors.

This training will help participants:

Understand how and why crisis events happen, and ways in which we might inadvertently contribute to them.

- Prevent crises using a variety of supportive interaction strategies.
- Apply simple, evidence-based de-escalation strategies that are effective for any population.
- Respond appropriately and safely to dangerous behavior.
- Use safe physical management procedures in compliance with state and federal guidelines.
- Intervene after a crisis to reduce the chance that it will happen again.

This service provides training for both initial certification (13 hours) and for recertification (6 ½ hours) in Safety-Care Training. The training schedule can be accessed on 48 Carats. Specially scheduled sessions for individual programs and districts can be arranged by contacting the supervisor.
